LOWER WEEKDAY RATES!

Want to avoid paying ^s6 per hour for weekday access to the ImagiNation Network? Now you can, thanks to our new partnership with AT&T and their network of PREFERRED local access numbers you can use to dial in.

When you install your software for Version 2.4 you can choose a new local access number for dialing into the ImagiNation Network. In many parts of the country, members will be able to choose lower weekday rates by selecting a Preferred Access Number— marked on the install screen with an asterisk.

We'll be sending you easy, step-by-step instructions on how to install your new software and select a preferred local access number if one is available in your area. In many cases, this number will already be highlighted for you.

But just in case it is not, move the highlighted area to a number marked with an asterisk. When you do, you will avoid paying the ^s6 weekday rate for online access between the hours of 7a.m. to 6 p.m. PLUS, the online hours included in your Membership Plan will be accessible 24 hours a day.

Although Preferred Local Access Numbers are not available in all parts of the country, we'll be adding more in the coming year.

Lower rates and 24 hour a day access? Thanks, AT&T!

Well, the first thing you've got to do is register your club. It's easy enough to do this, fortunately. Just write to the ImagiNation Network Conference Manager at E-mail Box 931. When you send the Conference Manager all the info about your club, it'll be listed online in the Town Hall and you can get even more people interested in joining. PLUS, you'll get a conference reservation in a room of the Clubhouse so that you won't be scrounging around on your own to find a quiet place to meet. Good luck! Clubs are lots of fun.

Hey Fred!

I don't mean to be unfriendly, but there's this person online who keeps saying very rude things to me. Being nice back just isn't working. Any advice?

Dear Bummed:

Yes, it's a drag when someone just won't be polite online. My motto is, "If you can't say anything nice, don't say anything at all." No one should have to put up with rude, crude behavior from another member. Not anytime, anywhere. So, you might want to try this: First, tell the person you don't appreciate their comments. Then, if they persist, press the MUTE button so that you don't have to hear anything more from them during the time vou're online that session. And remember that you can also press the COMPLAIN button if you feel that the comments have violated Community Standards. A copy of the Community Standards is posted online in the Town Hall, by the way. Good luck, and remember that one bad apple doesn't spoil the whole bunch!

DO IT YOURSELF

If you find yourself in the position of "cruise director" for a member get-together, consider these tips from longtime ImagiNation Network member Shelley Covalcine, known online as "Laughter". She has organized several member gatherings in her time, including the April, 1994, get-together in Fresno, Calf. and the "Laughing Lunatic Lazy Lancaster Layover" held March 1995 in Lancaster, Calif.

· Make sure to plan enough activities to keep folks busy, but don't overwhelm them with too much to do. A certain amount of activities helps get the ball rolling, justdon't overestimate the need people have to relax and proceed at their own pace.

- Create opportunities for people to make new friends. Choose "get to know you" games and other activities that make it easy for people to introduce themselves
- Plan an event that is affordable for a wide variety of people. Not everyone can afford a weekend getaway to an exotic locale. When choosing a city for your gettogether, consider the affordability factor in airfare, hotels, meals, and
- Give people options for activities. Smaller groups are more conducive to building friendships. Instead of one big group outing, you might let people choose between an afternoon sightseeing tour or an informal get-together at the hotel pool.

REAL QUESTIONS FROM REAL MEMBERS TO IMAGINATION'S MEMBER SERVICES

- Q: Why is it that every time I try to connect to the ImagiNation Network I hear a busy signal?
- A: Verify that you are calling a valid access phone number for the ImagiNation Network. To do this, type INSTALL from the directory in which you installed the ImagiNation Network (usually C:\INN). On the Installation Choices screen, highlight ACCESS PHONE # and press [Enter]. Press the [F1] function key, enter your area code and press [Enter] again. Highlight a phone number from the provided list and press [Enter]. Follow the on-screen prompts. If the problem persists, please report the busy access phone number to Member Services
- Q: How do I quit 3-D Golf?
- A: Press [Alt-X], or press [Ctrl-Q] or press [Ctrl-Esc].
- Q: How do I get into CasinoLand?
- A: Since CasinoLand is the casino games area for members 18 years or older, we must receive proof that you are 18 years of age or older for access. To obtain CasinoLand access, simply write us a note stating

that you are in fact 18 years of age or older, sign it and fax it to us at (209) 642-0885. You can also request CasinoLand access online in the ImagiNation Network Mall or you can mail a request to us at P.O. Box 1550, Oakhurst, CA 93644. However, if you don't see CasinoLand in the upper left-hand corner of the Map, your copy of the software may not include it. If this is the case, you can call Member Services to order an upgrade. Also, if you installed from a single 3.5" disk, you will need to install the full version of the ImagiNation Network software that is automatically mailed to you once you become a member.
